

Examination of the skin and appendages:

- 1. coat
- 2. skin
- 3. skin/mucous membrane transitions
- 4. ears
- 5. bales (esp. digital hyperkeratosis)

Examination of the eyes:

- 1. eye position
- 2. pupillary reflex
- 3. eyelid position
- 4. tears outflow

Examination of the front and hind limbs at rest and movement:

- 1. burden, discharge
- 2. symmetry / deformity
- 3. atrophy / swelling (muscles and joints).....
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- 4. conspicuousness in way of walking yes no
- 5. suspected patella luxation yes no

Examination of the external genitalia:

Male dog:

- 1. prepuce
- 2. penis
- 3. testicles

female dog:

- 1. vaginal atrium
- 2. udder

Examination of the nervous system:

- 1. motility
- 2. reflexes
- 3. ataxias
- 4. senses
- 5. deviations from standard behavior (e.g. overly anxious, aggressive, apathetic, etc.)
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Final judgement from vet.med. view,
Interpretation/prognosis of abnormal test results,
recommendations:

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The identity of the dog is verified on the transponder number and compared with the entries in the original pedigree.
